Should we go to school when it is snowing?

Yes! But sometimes conditions can be difficult when large amounts of snow falls. The arrangements in this leaflet should answer any questions you may have. Every effort will be made to ensure our school remains open but the safety of children and staff is our main consideration at all times. If home for a day due to school closure the children can access internet sites we use in school e.g. Sumdog, Education City etc, they can read and complete outstanding HW tasks, do some online research for something they are learning about in school or they can even write a diary of how they used their snowy day, practise their times tables etc. All children have online library access to digital books. Log in for this has already been sent home. Outside time and fresh air is also encouraged!

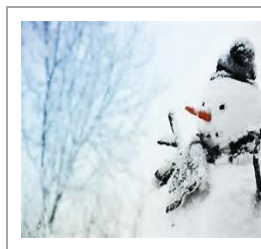
What happens when heavy snow falls during the school day?



Where possible we shall try to keep the school open and provide normal teaching. However, if conditions worsen, it may be necessary to close during the day. If staff live in outlying areas we may need to allow them to travel home early. This may mean your child may not be taught by their class teacher for the full day. Another staff member would cover the class in this instance.



Should we need to close the school a text message will be sent to parents. If we have to close, children will not be permitted to leave school without firstly contacting parents to ensure each child is returned to a responsible adult.
