## School Values

Respect is at the core of everything we do in school. It underpins learning through behaviour and our attitudes to the people and the world around us. We have given thought to what respect looks like in the classroom, in the playground, at home and in the community.

How you can help at home:

- Discuss what it means to be respectful and to be respected.
- Ask your child about 'Respectabella' and talk about ways they could earn her stickers.
- Use the language of respect at home.

Reflection points:

- Respect is feeling good about myself.
- Respect is knowing I am unique and valuable.
- Respect is knowing I am lovable and capable.
- Respect is listening to others.
- Respect is knowing others are valuable too.

The best way to teach RESPECT is to show RESPECT. When a child experiences RESPECT, they know what it feels like and begins to understand how important it is.
